I acknowledge that under the provisions of M.G.L. Chapter 41, Section 91B the Chief of Police will investigate my reputation and character and fitness for this office.		
I also understand that under the provisions of M.G.L. Chapter 41, Section 92, that I will required to obtain a bond as set forth herein: A constable who has given bond to the torin a sum of not less than one thousand dollars, with sureties approved by the selectment conditioned for the faithful performance of his duties in the service of all civil processed committed to him, and has filed the same, with the approval of the selectmen endorsed thereon, with the town clerk, may within his town serve any writ or other process in a personal action in which the damages are not laid at a greater sum than two hundred dollars, and in replevin in which the subject matter does not exceed in value two hundred dollars, and any writ or other process under chapter two hundred and thirty-nine. A constable who has filed such a bond, in a sum of not less than five thousand dollars, may within his town, also serve any such writ or other process in which the damages are laid at a sum not exceeding \$7,000, and any process in replevin in which the subject matter does not exceed in value \$7,000.		
I also acknowledge that under M/G.L. Chapter 41, Section 95A that: Constables appointed under sections 91, 91A, and 91B or otherwise elected to serve as constables a city or town shall periodically pay the city or town in which the constable is appointe or elected 25 per cent of all fees the constable collects for the service of civil process under the fee structure established in section 8 of chapter 262. This payment shall be made in installments to be deposited with the city or town treasurer not later than Janua 15, April 15, July 15 and October 15 of each year, but a constable having less than \$50 to deposit at that time shall hold the share for deposit until the sooner of October 15 or the time when the amount due to the city or town under this section equals or exceeds \$500.
